Dear Pastors, Prayer Partners, and Friends,

"But he knoweth the way that I take..." (Job 23:10) As we reflect on almost 8 years in full-time missions, we thank the Lord for His faithful guidance. We have not always understood His plan, but we have trusted He always knows best. We praise Him for answering prayer and allowing us to return to Fiji on February 19th.

Update on Mikayah

Mikayah has been diagnosed with a mild case of Rheumatic Heart Disease and is receiving Benzathine Penicillin injections every 4 weeks, with a review ECHO scheduled for the beginning of next year. Doctors are hopeful for improvement as she grows which may allow her to be removed from treatments.

We also praise the Lord that her abdominal pain has resolved since January. After consulting specialists at the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP), it appears the issue was related to neurological triggers, which have now subsided. Thank you for your prayers, encouragement, and financial support during this time. God has provided our every need!

Back in Fiji

Since returning, we have adjusted through heavy rain and flooding (with a few canceled services), but are thankful to be entering the cooler season soon. We have resumed ministry in Sigatoka, holding youth meetings, a ladies' meeting, a pastor's meeting, and outreach ministries.

Looking Forward

- **Junior Camp:** Preparations have begun for Junior camp: May 5th–8th
- **Dormitory Project:** The work came to a halt while we were gone due to the rainy weather and losing some workers to other jobs. We pray we can resume work in April as the weather improves. We have a construction team arriving late June from the USA. We are praying the dormitory will be complete this year.
- **Family Update:** Josh's father is recovering from open-heart surgery and having cataract surgery in March & April. Once Josh's father is cleared, they plan to return to Fiji in June Lord-willing.
- **Baby Update:** Overall, Frances' pregnancy has gone well. Our baby girl is due July 14th.

Thank you for your continued prayers and support as we serve here in Fiji.
