We continue to praise God for what he accomplishes in us, through us, and sometimes, despite us. February was another month full of blessings and challenges.

VBS this year was based again on a superhero theme, with the boys and girls divided into the leagues of Faith and Love. We had an average attendance of 90 children plus their parents, which has been consistent post-COVID. Pastor Alex and Stacy shared the teaching responsibilities this year and ended up competing against one another in many of the team games (at the kids' request). Although Stacy is almost 20 years older, he kept up well. We have several children who continue to come on Sundays, and we trust that some parents will as well. One of the things we consistently struggle with is that families come for special activities but do not continue to attend regularly. Please pray with us that God will show us ways that we can improve that.

We have focused this month's Sunday morning messages on sharing the church's mission and vision for 2026. Like many churches, ours has grown comfortable with the status quo and has become lax in basic, necessary practices like faithful attendance, giving, discipleship, and soulwinning. We must push away from the table and get back to work in the fields.

We were able to step away for a few days and look at the options for a newer vehicle. We narrowed it down to 2 options; now we just need to wait for the vehicles to become available. Here in Peru, there are no dealerships with inventory or places like CarMax. Once you find a

vehicle, you must order it and wait for delivery, which can take up to 30 days due to title and registration. Although we have the money, we need to wait until the model, color, and features become available. Stacy is making his first of three trips to Chile this year. The first one, starting on the 27th, will be with Jeremiah 38, working in the Temuco area, 8 hours south of Santiago. The second will be for seminary graduation ceremonies, and the last will be for a mission conference in October. We will also be working with Jeremiah 38 two more times this year, once in June and the other in October.

The family is going well. Jennifer has been inundated with work due to the multiple massive snow and ice storms that affected her entire site footprint.

Weston's surgery was successful, and recovery has been uneventful. Stacy's grandmother, 99, fell and shattered her femur. Please pray for her recovery.
