As anticipated, March took off like a shot with many of our regular year-round ministries cranking back up. We praise the Lord for another great start.

Homeschool GLM started on March 3 with 49 students—1 in preschool, 25 in elementary, and 23 in high school. Apart from pastors and missionaries, we have families from all over Peru and some in other parts of the world that want to keep their children in the Peruvian system of education. We are thankful to give these families the opportunity to provide their children with a Christ-centered, individualized education.

Our men's and ladies' Bible studies began on March 8. Our people specifically asked for a parallel study that both the men and women could study together and talk about the week between. We are working through "Disciplines of a Godly Man/Woman" by Kent and Barbara Hughes this year. While we are away, couples will take turns doing the lessons and coordinating the meetings giving them additional experience during the transition.

We finished our two-month study on spiritual gifts and plugged just about all of the members into ministries that permit them to put their gifts into practice. Approximately 78% of our congregation is now involved in the work, allowing us to add

additional Sunday school and children's church classes and distribute the responsibilities more evenly among the congregation. We also shifted some people around to suit their gifts better and called a new deacon.

On March 28-30, we had our third annual mission conference with missionary Miguel Gargate from Tingo Maria in the central jungle of Peru. His wife and son were also with us. It benefitted our church in several ways, but mostly because our ministries are very similar in size. We trust that our people were helped, that the Holy Spirit will use the messages to promote a deeper love for missions, and that they will continue to assume more responsibility in work because of the examples around them.
