Welcome to another monthly installation of what the Lord is doing in Peru. We are always amazed at what he allows us to be a part of in the grand plan.

As mentioned in the previous newsletter, Stacy had the opportunity to collaborate with pastors Pedro and Fernando in Temuco, Chile, alongside Jeremiah 38. Due to recent medication issues, all the medicines were held up in customs for the duration of the trip. Fortunately, we had purchased some in-country, and another organization donated others for us. On the two days that we worked with the local municipality, they offered us access to their pharmacies, so we were able to see everyone, just not to the extent we are accustomed to. All in all, we saw the Lord's hand in all of this, and the primary goal of sharing the Gospel and helping the local churches was accomplished.

The messages in February and March regarding commitment to the Lord's work seem to be bearing fruit. One of our former members has rejoined the church, and others are expressing interest in joining as well. On the 29th, we received our faith promise commitments and held the elections for our new board members. The new board members will begin their terms in July.

Our missions conference was led this year by one of the missionaries we support, Marcos Torres. His family serves in Ventanilla, north of the airport, and has spent the last two years growing the primary work, also adding a second ministry not far from the original. The messages he brought during the conference were exactly what the congregation needed to hear.

Both the weekly Bible club and ladies' meetings have restarted. We hope to start the youth group and men's meetings soon. As Pastor Alex assumes more responsibility, he is finding it challenging to hand over what he has historically done to others. This is not because he doesn't want to, but because others are not yet ready to assume it. Please help us pray that the Lord will provide the workers we need.

The Lord led us in a completely different direction regarding our vehicle. After several weeks without hearing from the dealer, Stacy went to the lot and spoke with him. Due to the current demand for cars, we felt led to consider a different option, which appears to be the better choice. We have reserved the vehicle and should hear more by the middle of April.
