In January, God allowed us to be back in the Philippines for about a month, and we were privileged to experience the blessing of seeing the men that we trained in our Bible college, some since they were children, to finally be ordained into the gospel ministry. I can personally say that one of the biggest blessings of the mission field is seeing those very kids, become faithful teens in the youth group, then Bible college students, and now faithful ministers of the gospel, and eventually to see them now serving the Lord as pastors. We had our church anniversary service and we were blessed to have Pastor Tom Krampert, Jr of Norwood, MA preach for us this special occasion. He also challenged the church in their missions giving and we saw the highest increase in our missions giving than we have seen yet. To God be the glory for all that he has done.

One of the young men who we ordained in January (Kleint), is now currently on deputation heading to Taiwan. He started his deputation in January, and already has 18 supporting churches, these are all churches from the Philippines. He is planning on starting deaf and hearing churches there. He recently preached at Bethany Baptist Church in Makati pastored by Dr. Gerry Nable. After his preaching, the pastor introduced him to a single missionary lady who was also on deputation, and after speaking to her parents they, started a relationship. I told Kleint, "It's the first time I have seen a guest speaker get a girlfriend as a love gift from a church." We laughed together about that, but we are thrilled how God is blessing his deputation.

Ten years ago, we were able to get into a public high school in the Philippines where I preached to the unsaved students. After the lecture, a 12-year-old boy named Argie came up to me to strike up a conversation. He didn't know it, but I prayed to the Lord before the class, "If you want to me to invest in a soul here Lord, there are so many, and I don't know which one, but please bring him up to me to talk to me after the class." Argie came up and talked to me, and so I collected his information, visited him, and eventually saw him saved,









baptized and graduated from our Bibe college. That young man gave his heart to the Lord! I later found out that he actually use to deliver drugs for his father when he was a child. Thankfully, Argie is now on our church staff, and thoroughly enjoying serving the Lord. He has surrendered for the mission field and is getting married at the end of this year to a young lady on our church staff. It is amazing where the Lord will take you, when you give your heart to him! God's hand is on this young man, and we are blessed in his ministry of leading the orchestra. Pray for him and Wendy as they will be married and continue to serve the Lord together.

We are already about ¾ the way finished with our furlough, and have been thoroughly blessed by the Lord and His people. Seeing how God is still working in churches, seeing souls saved, and seeing churches still investing in world missions has been such an encouragement.
